



# What is the future continuous tense?

1. *Used to point out that a future action will take place over a length of time and won't happen all at once*
2. *Used to make comparisons between the present and the future*
3. *Used to say that more than one future event will be happening at the same time*

Rule	Examples
use the phrase <b>will be</b> followed by the present participle of the verb	I <b>will be swimming</b> . They <b>will be swimming</b> .
<b>will be + verb-ing</b>
