

## What is the future continuous tense?

 Used to point out that a future action will take place over a length of time and won't happen all at once
Used to make comparisons between the present and the future
Used to say that more than one future event will be happening at the same time

Rule	Examples
use the phrase <b>will be</b> followed by the present participle of the verb	I will be swimming.
will be + verb-ing	They <b>will be swimming</b> .
