



What is the future perfect continuous tense?

1. *used to state that a future action will happen over a period of time before some other future event interrupts it or stops it*
2. *can often be used interchangeably with the future continuous tense*

Rule

use the phrase **will have been** followed by the present participle of the verb

will have been + verb -ing

Examples

Olaf and Annie **will have been** building snowmen for a while when Christopher arrives.
