

What is the future perfect tense?

used to say that an event was finished before a certain time or before another event (only refers to actions or states that will be completely finished in the future)

Rule	Examples
use the phrase will have followed by the past participle of the verb will have + verb -ed / -d / -t	They will have jogged three miles before reaching the beach.
