

What is the past continuous tense?

- 1. used to describe an action that was interrupted by another event
- 2. used to express that two actions or states were happening at the exact same time
 - 3. used to say that an action or state was in progress at a specific time

Rule	Examples
past tense of the verb be followed by the present participle of the verb	I was reading . We were reading .
was/were + verb-ing	were redding.
