

What is the past perfect continuous tense?

used to indicate that an action began in the past, continued for a period of time, and ended in the past

Rule	Examples
use the phrase had been followed by the present participle of the verb	Our team had been looking for an outfielder for not even an hour when
had been + verb -ing	we found the perfect person.
